- A personal Gallery page in the PaperWorks Members online Gallery OR
- A web address for a personal artist website

NOTE: These are the ONLY two ways to submit for consideration. Individual jpeg images will not be accepted. If you do not currently have an artist page in the PaperWorks Members Gallery, visit the Gallery page on the PaperWorks website and click on the “Submission Guidelines” button to download a pdf file with instructions for creating your Gallery page.

Exhibit Guidelines

Please read the following carefully; delivered work that does not meet the size and presentation requirements will not be accepted into the exhibit

Dates and Deadlines

Exhibition Dates: Sept 1 - Oct 28

Artist Reception: Sept 17, 6:00 to 8:30 pm (on the full supermoon!)

MAY 1 Deadline for members to provide a link for their gallery page/website to exhibitions@paperworks.info

June 15 Kevin sends PaperWorks exhibition committee the list of selected artists

June 17 Accepted artists receive notification from PW exhibition committee by this date

AUGUST 20 - 27 Artists deliver work to Arte de la Vida during their regular business days and hours (10am – 5pm, Tues – Sat). *Work will not be accepted before or after these dates and/or times.*

OCTOBER 29 On this day only: Pickup unsold art or check payment for sold work during Arte de la Vida business hours.

Theme, Media, Format, Size, & Presentation Requirements

- Work must reflect some aspect of the exhibition’s theme, LA LUNA
- Any media artists choose to work in; must meet the format and size requirements
- Square format; 2D or 3D work no larger than 14” in any dimension; only ONE work per each artist
- All work must be professionally presented and/or framed (no sawtooth hangers) and ready for hanging or pedestal display (for 3D work only). DO NOT deliver more than ONE work. Arte de la Vida reserves the right to not accept artwork that does not meet these requirements!
- All works must remain in the gallery for the entire duration of the exhibit

Sale of Work

- All work must be for sale, priced to reflect the current Tucson art market and no higher than \$500.00
- 50% gallery commission on all sales
